

In memoriam: Luminița STATE (1948 –2016)

Mrs. Luminița State (born on January 27th, 1948), Professor, PhD., Pitești University, Faculty of Mathematics and Informatics, Department of Informatics, distinguished member of the Romanian academic community, passed away January 9th, 2016. Her vast scientific activity, nationally and internationally recognized, is reflected in over 200 scientific works, papers, studies, monographs, university manuals and also ambitious research projects in collaboration with European and American universities. Mrs. Professor Luminita State has published in the *Informatica Economică* journal, as author or co-author, a series of valuable papers in the fields of Artificial Intelligence, Neuronal Computation Systems, Mathematics Methods for Analysis and Processing Signals and Pattern Recognition and Classification.
