

## Informatica Economică at the 100th Issue

Informatica Economică Journal has reached a milestone: issue 100, in a volume that is also a milestone and has many meanings: volume 25. As a number, 25 is compound, semi-prime, automorphic, aspiring, brilliant, strong, round, perfect square, octagonally centered etc. Additionally, the spiritual numerological dimension unites two numbers with opposite meanings: 2 and 5 – creativity inside behavioral boundaries, of possible and impossible, without limits. *All these are also characteristics of our Journal.*

In 25 year of continuous publishing (1997-2021), Informatica Economică Journal featured **over 800 authors**, university and high-school professors, doctors of science, doctoral students, specialists and researchers from Romania and abroad. Thus, the Journal enjoys a broad international recognition, being listed/indexed in various international scientific databases like Directory of Open Access Journal (DOAJ), Cabell's Directories of Publishing Opportunities, EBSCO (Business Source Complete), ICAAP, Index Copernicus, Index of Information Systems Journals, Inspec, Open J-Gate, ProQuest Central, RePec, Ulrich's Periodicals Directory. Also, the editorial board of the Journal features 45 specialists, academicians and renowned professors from universities with informatics programs, from Romania and also from Germany, France, United Kingdom, Italy, Spain, Russia, Hungary, USA, Japan, China, Egypt, Chile etc.

Started in 1997 as an initiative of the professors of Department of Economic Informatics (today Department of Economic Informatics and Cybernetics) led by Mr. Prof. Ion Gh. Roșca, the Informatica Economică Journal enjoyed for the first 12 years the financial support of National Education Ministry, Bucharest Economics Publishing House and INFOREC association. Later it was the INFOREC association who supported the financial side of publishing the Journal.

During the years, the management of the Journal was the task of three teams of professors that did a significant work, voluntarily, for the good of the Journal: attracting articles, editing the text and figures in the articles, processing the articles, reviewing, desktop publishing and printing. The management teams were lead, in turn, by prof. Bogdan Ghilic-Micu (1997-2009), prof. Ion Ivan (2009-2016), prof. Paul Pocatilu (2016-present). Congratulations to all!
